The Abbey Wood Urban Regeneration Framework (URF) is built around a long-term vision designed to deliver positive change for our communities over the next decade. The Framework identifies three areas in Abbey Wood which will benefit most from future investment, ensuring the area can evolve into a safer, healthier and more sustainable neighbourhood for everyone. Stitching these places together will be improved streets, enhanced parks with better play connected by green links.

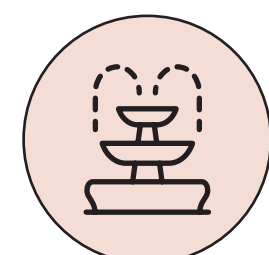
We have categorised our ideas into four overarching themes:

1. Revitalise Abbey Wood Village



Our approach: Revitalise the high streets and public spaces around Abbey Wood Station to create a vibrant and welcoming village centre.

3. Rebalancing Harrow Manorway



Our approach: Continue to improve Harrow Manorway and build on what's already working by exploring further opportunities and targeted interventions. This will allow us to easily adapt to changing circumstances and support our future needs.

2. Transform Eynsham Drive



Our approach: Transform this key local centre to deliver retail, civic, and community facilities that serve the needs of local residents, stakeholders and businesses. As part of improvements, explore the opportunity to retrofit or build new homes where most needed.

4. Connecting our community with nature



Our approach: Enhance parks, green links, streets, and play spaces to better meet the current and future needs of Abbey Wood's residents.

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Vision: 4 Key Moves

1 - Revitalise Abbey Wood Village

Revitalise the high streets and public spaces around Abbey Wood Station to create a vibrant and welcoming village centre.

2 - Transform Eynsham Drive

Transform the key local centre to deliver new homes, retail, civic, and community facilities that serve the needs of local residents.

3 - Improve Harrow Manorway

Improve the major arterial road forming the boundary between Greenwich and Bexley by enhancing transport connections, supporting active travel, and making the street safer for pedestrians.

4 - Create Safe Green Links & Parks

Enhance parks, green links, streets, and play spaces to better meet the current and future needs of Abbey Wood's residents.
